2018 Sports Uniform Structure and PDHPE Practicals

Years 7 to 10 PDHPE and Years 9 to 10 PASS >

Periods 1, 2, and 4

Wear College uniform to school;
Change into PE-Sports uniform at the beginning of the lesson;
Change back into College uniform at the end of lesson.

Period 3

Wear College uniform to school;
Change into PE-Sports uniform at recess if a period 3 lesson;
Change back into College uniform at the end of lesson.

Period 5

Wear College uniform to school;
Change into PE-Sports uniform at lunch if a period 5 lesson;
Change back into College uniform at the end of lesson.

The only time PDHPE & PASS students are in practical PE-Sports uniform will be during recess, lunch and/or PDHPE/PASS class.

Tuesday Sport: Years 7, 8, 11 SLR and 12 SLR >

Wear PE-Sports uniform to school.

Friday Sport: Years 9 and 10 >

Wear PE-Sports uniform to school.

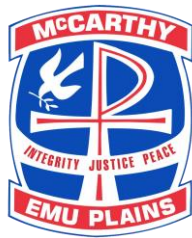
Thursday Representative Sport >

Wear full Sports Uniform to school and carry rep uniform in bag
Change into Rep Uniform at Recess
Depart school or venue in full Sports Uniform.

Note: All Rep Sports Students will have a season pass sticker to put in the back of their diary to indicate to their Homeroom and teachers that they have representative privileges on a Thursday to wear Sports Uniform.

If Rep Sports Students are not in full Sports Uniform to and from the College, they must wear their full College Uniform or they will not represent the College on that day (as a consequence for incorrect uniform to College). If students do not get changed from Rep Sports Uniform back into Sports Uniform at the venue/College the consequence is to miss sports representation the following week.

Teachers are to follow Student Management Consequences for Out of Uniform.



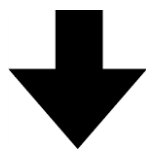
2018 PDHPE Practicals

PE Uniform Management Procedure

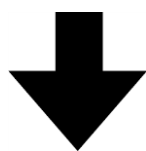
Students are required to have their tools for learning every lesson.

The following procedure begins at the commencement of each term in the case of lack of equipment (no PE-Sports uniform):

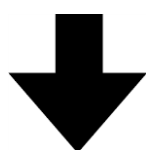
1st offence - Teacher interviews student and documents in chronicle or roll
(understanding the behaviour, supporting the student,
and an explanation of expectations)



2nd offence - Teacher interviews student, documents in chronicle or roll and communicates with parents
(via diary OR letter OR phone call)



3rd offence - Teacher communicates with parents, documents in chronicle or roll, organises a recess/lunch detention, and informs PDHPE LOL



4th offence - Teacher phones parents, documents the incident on FACES, organises a meeting between student, teacher and PDHPE LOL (who will action and afternoon detention), and inform Year LOL

Students not participating need to be writing OR working on assessments OR picking up rubbish OR helping with the lesson (eg. providing feedback to their peers from the sideline, grading, peer assessing, refereeing, setting up field).
